

Disposal Procedures for Used or Expired Glutaraldehyde or ortho-Phthalaldehyde (OPA)

- 1. Add Glute-Out neutralizer, as per instructions on the bottle, to the GUS cylinder, tray or other container. Glute-Out is a glycine-based powder neutralizer that deactivates glutaraldehyde and OPA.
 - Check expiration date of Glute-Out. Don't use if expired.
 - The amount of Glute-Out used depends on the quantity of OPA or glutaraldehyde to be disposed:
- 2. <u>OPA</u>: Wait a minimum of <u>1 hour</u> for neutralization to occur, the color will change from yellow orange to green brown.

<u>Glutaraldehyde</u>: Wait <u>5 minutes</u> for neutralization to occur, the color will change from yellow orange to red orange.

Approximate quantity of OPA or glutaraldehyde to drain dispose	Quantity of Glute Out needed to neutralize (NG-1GAL or NG-5GAL)
1 Quart	Use 1/2 ounce (1/4 bottle of NG-1GAL)
1 Gallon	Use 2 ounces (1 bottle of NG-1GAL)
5 Gallons	Use 10 ounces (1 bottle of NG-5GAL)
7.5 Gallons	Use 15 ounces (1-1/2 bottles of NG-5GAL)

- 3. **Run cold water** during and after disposal down the drain.
- 4. **Wash cylinder, tray or other container** with detergent and water. Then, **rinse with sterile water** and **dry** with absorbent sterile towel before refilling.
