The New York State Department of Health, Bureau of Radiation Protection (BERP) concluded their three day inspection of our Broad Scope Radioactive Materials License on July 31, 2024, and announced that there were no violations and only two recommendations.

The scope of the inspection included diagnostic and therapeutic nuclear medicine at the hospital and the ambulatory care pavilion, cyclotron and research imaging, human research subjects use, training programs, internal approval and permitting processes, physician authorized users approval process, radiation oncology, research laboratories, calibration program, radioactive waste storage on East and West campus and the quantities of concern program.

A tremendous amount of effort has gone into updating policies, procedures, training, and for revising the way that the group performs their work, and this has paid off. This effort helps to support the University's strategic plan and priority for "[Reimagining the Way We Work](#)" and strengthening operational maturity and effectiveness by modernizing our technology, developing consistent and equitable policies and procedures, and investing in our infrastructure and facilities.
