Program Description:

The MBA Fast Track program combines a four year undergraduate degree and a two year MBA into a program that can be completed in as little as five years. Undergraduate students in this program take graduate MBA courses beginning either the summer after their sophomore or junior year. They continue with MBA courses during

their senior year and then finish their MBA program in their fifth year. The MBA degree has become increasingly popular for students considering careers in business, healthcare, law, science, research, and other professions. It is the degree of choice for anyone interested in taking on a leadership role in an organization. Our program provides students with opportunities to gain real-world experience through projects and internships with companies in a variety of industries, including private and public companies, not-for-profit organizations, as well. - 2-3 letters of recommendation
- Interview with admissions committee
