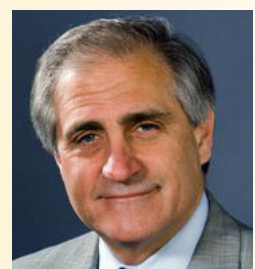
Reuven Pasternak is Chief Executive Officer and Vice President for Health Systems of Stony Brook University Hospital.
