

## Committees, Offices, and Roles Related to Assessment

<a href="#"><u>Office of Educational Effectiveness (OEE)</u></a>	<p>Administrative Office in the Provostial area with five highly motivated and enthusiastic experts to enable and <b>support the implementation of high-quality processes to measure both student learning and administrative outcomes</b> to sustain and advance excellence.</p>
<a href="#"><u>Middle States Working Group 5- Educational Effectiveness Assessment</u></a>	<p>Working group of faculty and staff <b>charged with demonstrating how SBU meets accreditation requirements to demonstrate that our students have accomplished educational goals</b> determined by the faculty and that assessment results are used for improvement. Work group activities 2022-2024.</p>
<a href="#"><u>Assessment Coordinator</u></a>	<p>A faculty member, program director, or administrator <b>identified to coordinate assessment activities at the program level</b>. Serves as the primary liaison between the program and the Office of Educational Effectiveness.</p>
<p><b>Assessment Council</b></p>	<p>A council of faculty members, charged by the Provost in consultation with the University Senate, <b>to develop campus-wide policies and procedures for academic assessment</b>, including general education and to provide ongoing oversight of assessment of student learning.</p>
<p><b>General Education Advisory Committee</b></p>	<p>An advisory committee of 12 faculty and 4 administrators, jointly constituted by University Senate and the Provost, <b>charged with providing ongoing advice about the implementation, evaluation, and assessment of Stony Brook University's general education curriculum</b>.</p>
<p><b>Ad Hoc Committee to Establish a Program Review Process</b></p>	<p>An ad hoc committee of 5 department chairs <b>charged with recommending a process for a periodic review of Stony Brook's academic programs</b>, including a focus on assessment of student learning outcomes and an external review component, consistent with SUNY policy. Charge to be completed in fall 2022.</p>
